

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This memorandum of understanding is made this day, the 31st day of August 2022 between **M/s Eshaan Energy Private Limited**, #210, APHB Towers, Opp GVR Music College, BRTS Road, Vijayawada -520003, A.P hereinafter called the first party on the one part and **KVSR Siddhartha College of Pharmaceutical Sciences** hereinafter called the second party on other part.

Whereas the first party And the second party having got enrolled with the first party for collection, transporting, and disposal of **e-Waste** generated by the second party in their college.

And whereas both the parties felt it desirable and necessary to have the terms and conditions agreed upon put in writing. Now, therefore indenture is made as shown below.

1. Shall ensure regular lifting of all items of “**e- Waste**”, as defined under relevant Act and Rules made their under, from the premises of the second party on a regular basis. It includes computers, mainframes, monitors, printers, scanners, compact discs (CDs), The first party, after proper enrollment and complying with the procedures by the second party copiers, calculators, battery cells, cellular phones, fax machines, medical apparatus, refrigerators, and air conditioners and such other general items.
2. The first party will provide collection bins/bags with bar coding on payment bases to the second party and it shall be the responsibility of the second party to ensure collection of e-Waste generated in their premises in the bins/bags by their own staff and get them sealed and kept at a particular spot as identified by both the parties to enable the collection of the same by the staff of the first party.

3. The first party or their nominee will issue a proper receipt or acknowledgement of lifting of **e-Waste** from the premises of second party regularly to be counter signed by the second party or their nominee. While implementing bar-coding a digital manifest will be mailed to the second party.
4. The second party shall make payment of prescribed charges for the services rendered by the first party on a yearly basis. This charge is liable for the revision by the first party in consultation with APPCB Technical Committee and will be intimated in advance to the second party. The payments have to be made in the first week of the commencement of the financial year.
5. If the second party fails to make payment of charges or is found to be regularly irregularly, the first party will intimate to the APPCB (RO) and stop collection of **e-Waste** after 15 days of such intimation. In such cases, the discretion for re-enrollment of the second party lies within the first party after the receipt of all accumulated arrears with interest.
6. It shall be the sole responsibility of the second party to obtain authorization from APPCB after which only the first party will start collection of **e-Waste**.
7. Any dispute or difference of opinion between both the parties shall first be referred to IMA branches / APNA chapter for arbitrations failing which the matter will be settled in a court of law in Vijayawada, Krishna district of Andhra Pradesh.
8. Both parties shall ensure conformity with all norms, rules and procedures as prescribed from time to time by the appropriate Govt., or other competent authorities as both the parties share a joint responsibility to help for the protection of environment from hazardous **e-waste** generated in the premises..





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9. Any or all terms and conditions in this memorandum can be amended or modified at any time with the mutual consent of both the parties at any time.

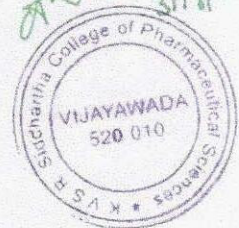

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding signed on this day of 24th February, 2022 by and between COASTAL TRADING Co, Vijayawada, represented by Mr Krishna Mohan Raavi having its office at Shed No 35, Phase 1, Auto Nagar, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh 520007 herein after called the FIRST PARTY

and

KVSR Siddhartha College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Polyclinic road, Vijayawada-520010 represented by Dr. A. Suneetha, Principal, KVSR Siddhartha College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, hereinafter called the SECOND PARTY.

COASTAL TRADING CO, Vijayawada, wholesaler of waste paper collects dry recyclable waste and sends to it M/s. Sree Godavari Kraft Papers Limited (SGKL), was incorporated as a Private Limited Company on 20th December 2000 under the Companies Act, 1956 with an objective to carry on the business of manufacturers, importers, exporters including Writing paper, Printing paper. The Head Office is located at D.No. 46-16-17, Danavaipeta, Rajahmundry-3, A.P. The Company went into commercial production in February 2002. The initial installed capacity was 4.500 MT per annum and subsequently increased the capacity to 9,000 MT per annum with additional capital investment. The Company earned the net profit in the first year of operations itself. The Company has shown good results for all the years

until now. In order to utilize the resources and the expertise gained in paper making this company has gone for an expansion of the installed capacity of 25,800 MT per annum of Newsprint, Writing, and Printing paper. The project is located at Retangi Village, Eragavaram Mandal, Near Tanuku, West Godavari District, in Andhra Pradesh State.

Whereas KVSR Siddhartha College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, has agreed to give away the paper waste, plastic waste and metal waste generated in its campus. The collected dry recyclables from KVSR Siddhartha College of Pharmaceutical Sciences will be initiated from as per the schedule, where both the parties agreed mutually.

MOU witness as follows

This MOU is intended to create a synergic alliance between KVSR Siddhartha College of Pharmaceutical Sciences & Coastal Trading Co for recycling the dry waste, which is a vital element in the protection of environment.

1. Definitions

- a) Waste Paper: discarded paper including card board, newspaper, magazines, shaded papers, old office records etc.
- b) Plastic: Water Bottles, Polythene sheets, carry bags. Pet bottles, CPVC material etc
- c) Metal waste: Iron scrap, condemned iron and other metals
- d) Designated Day: A day at the end of the semester agreed between the parties.

3. Quality and quantity

a) Material should be free from food particles, without any contamination of garbage, municipal waste or any item which are detrimental

b) Minimum required quantity is 200 Kgs

4. Roles and responsibilities of KVSR Siddhartha College of Pharmaceutical Sciences

a) KVSRSOPS shall identify the quantum of wastepaper and plastic generated at various locations in the campus

b) KVSRSOPS would store the waste paper and plastic and informs to Coastal Trading Co to pick up on mutually agreed schedule.

c) KVSRSOPS agrees to appoint J.Sushanth as its representative to coordinate on various activities identified in MOU and notify Coastal Trading Co within one month of any change in responsibility

d) KVSRSOPS needs to allocate for itself sufficient covered storage space for keeping the material safe.

e) A sale invoice in the name of the M/s. Coastal Trading Co shall be issued with local applicable VAT to enable faster payment from Coastal Trading Co Invoice will be sent by post/ courier to the address given in this Mou within two days from the date of collection of material along with the copies of the weighment slips.

f) Payment will be processed within two weeks from the date of receipt of the invoice along with gate pass and weighment slip.

Role and responsibilities of Coastal Trading Company

Payment Options:

a) In considerations for enabling Coastal Trading Co to pick up the materials from KVSR Siddhartha College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Coastal Trading Co shall pay to KVSR Siddhartha College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, the consideration amount based on weight recorded @Rs 71/- (Rupees Seven) per Kg cartoon Boxes, shredding Paper, Old News Paper, Old Magazine, Old office records Dustbin Paper @ Rs 8/- (Rupees Eight) per Kg For dry waste , plastic waste @ Rs 4/- (Rupees Four) per Kg, Metal waste @Rs 15/- (Rupees Fifteen)

per Kg etc Pay outs will be done to KVSR Siddhartha College of Pharmaceutical Sciences after collection of the materials.

b) Coastal Trading Co will make necessary arrangements for collecting the waste paper, plastic & metal waste Transporting to its godown.

c) Coastal trading Co shall not use or disseminate any confidential information printed on the waste paper if the waste paper is not properly shredded by KVSR Siddhartha College of Pharmaceutical Sciences and the information is legible

6. Roles and responsibilities

a) A conformation by both the parties that no benefit, either in cash or kind has been provided by the either party to the other party or to any officer or employee, or any relative/ associate institutions/ companies in order to enter into this agreement

b) An undertaking by both the parties not to provide any benefit, either in cash or kind to any officer/ employer/ relative/associate of any officer or employee of either party as reward or consideration either for the entering into this MOU or other matter relating to this agreement

c) Entry into Force and Duration: This agreement comes into force from 24th February 2022. Either party may terminate this agreement by giving thirty (30) days written notice to the other party. We wish to suggest for open ended document, and not a periodical document since this recycling activity is a continuing activity.

The first party and second party having read this document and understanding in full on this day of 24th February 2022 have affixed their signature to collaboratively work together.
